**„Mycotoxin Patterns in Food and Feed: Recent  
Evidences from Sub-Saharan Africa”**

Chibundu, Nigerian, holds BSc Microbiology (First Class Honours) from Babcock University (Nigeria), MSc Microbiology and PhD Mycology/ Mycotoxicology from the University of Ibadan, Nigeria. In the past 11 years, his research focused on mycotoxins and mycotoxigenic fungi in food and feed. His recent interest in bio-monitoring and exposure assessment of mycotoxins in humans seeks to understand mycotoxin co-exposure patterns and impact of interventions to effectively lower potential health risks in the African populace, especially among children. Chibundu has over 50 original research articles and chapters, mostly in high impact peer reviewed journals including Chemical Research in Toxicology, Environment International, European Food Research Technology, Food Additives and Contaminants Parts A and B, Food Control, International Journal of Food Microbiology, LWT– Food Science and Technology, Mycotoxin Research and the World Mycotoxin Journal. He recently concluded a Technical Advisor position (April 2015-July 2016) for the Partnership for Aflatoxin Control in Africa program of the African Union Commission at her Headquarters in Addis Ababa. In 2010, he was Research Fellow, then Visiting Scientist (April 2012–December 2013) at the International Institute of Tropical Agriculture, Nigeria, and Consultant (2014) to same organization for setting up laboratory infrastructure and building capacity at the Regional Mycotoxin Facility, Katumani, Kenya. He is Senior Lecturer in Food Microbiology/ Mycotoxicology at Babcock University and currently a Postdoc Researcher at the Centre for Analytical Chemistry, Department of Agrobiotechnology (IFA Tulln) of the University of Natural Resources and Life Sciences Vienna (BOKU), Austria. Chibundu is Co-Advisor for a PhD student here at the University of Vienna, and member of the American Society of Microbiology, Society for Applied Microbiology (UK). He also serves on the Board of the Mycotoxicology Society of Nigeria.
