Fragments: Towards Dynamic Fragment Libraries“**

Prof. Oliver Zerbe is a senior research fellow in the Department of Chemistry at the University of Zurich (UZH). His research interests are devoted to the structure elucidation of peptides or proteins of pharmacological relevance, especially of those binding to membranes. Moreover, he does research in the area of protein folding and glycolipids. A major emphasis of him at the moment is the structure of G-protein coupled receptors (GPCRs). In that context he is supervising graduate and diploma students. In addition he is organizing the NMR service at UZH.
